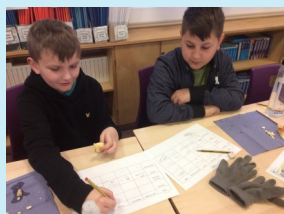

### In Class

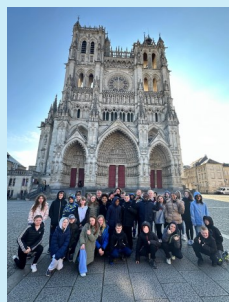
